# Tenable Spaces

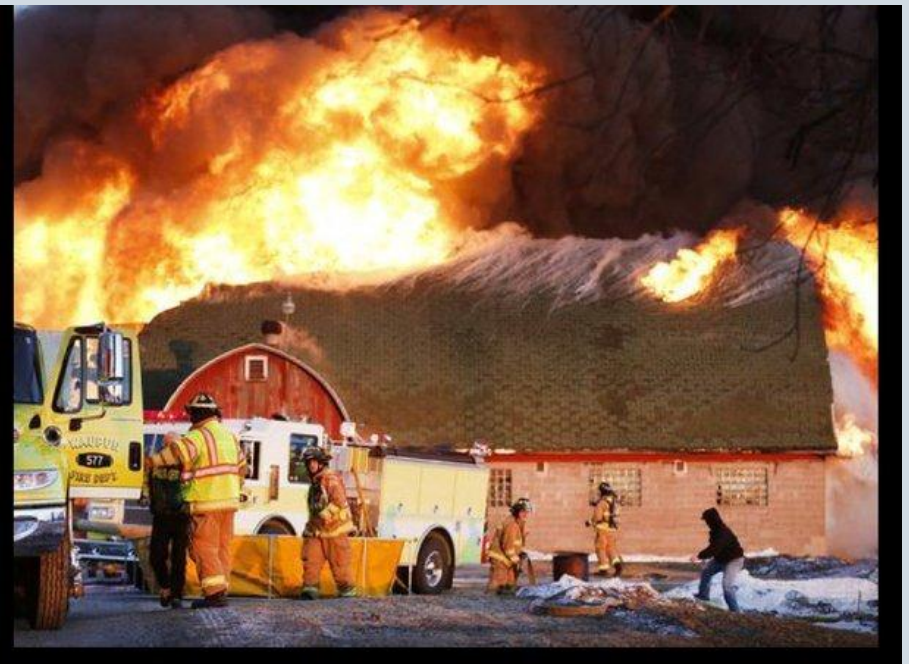
- These Spaces Must be Occupied! Look at this Picture There are Spaces that Victims Can be in.

- Raise the Standard so That the People that your Given Become the People you Want!!!

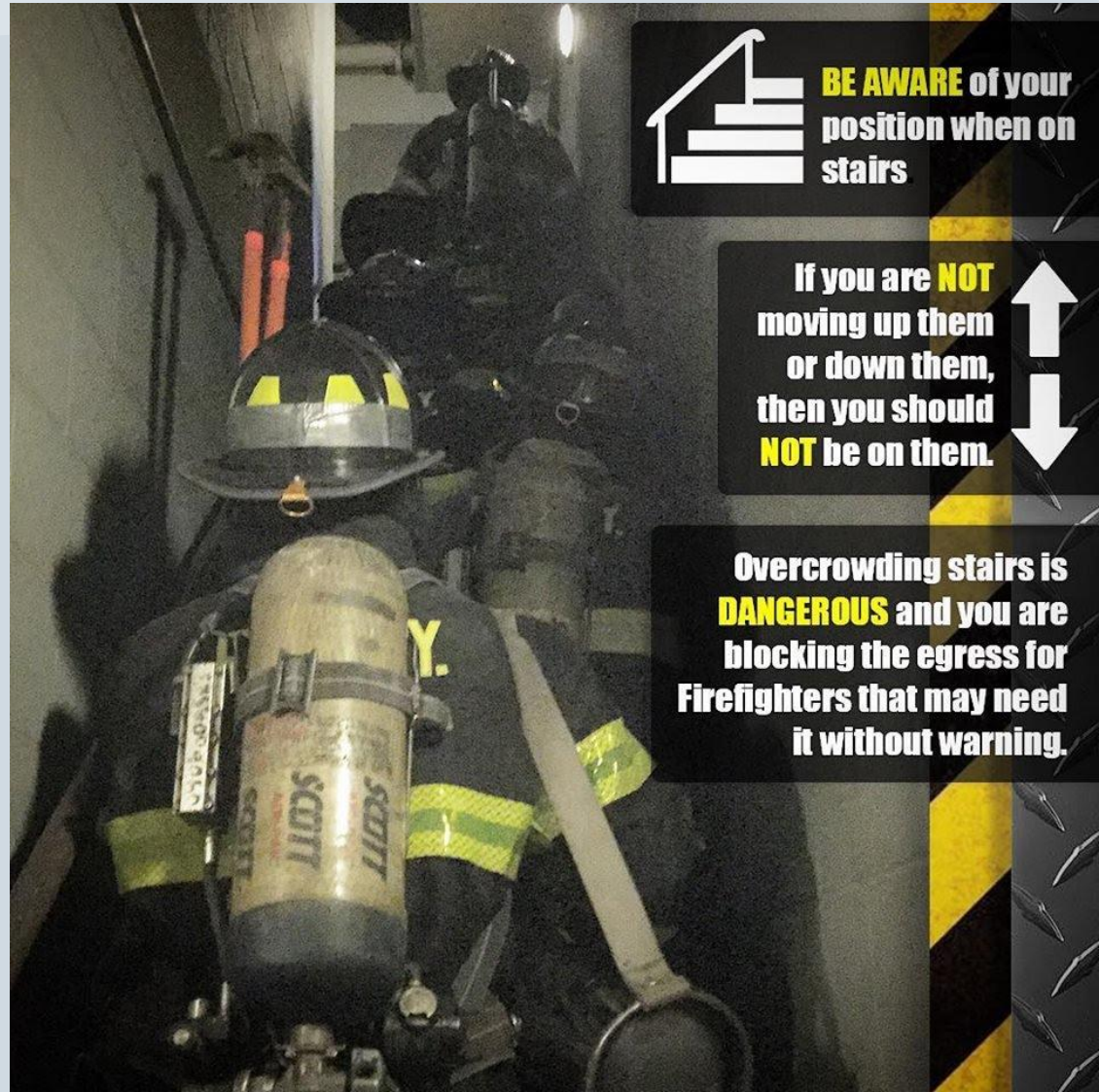


- Proficiency Doesn't have a Zip Code. Whether You go to 1 Fire a Year or 1 Every Day.

# Be Aware of Your Position When on Stairs.

- If you are not moving up or down them, then you should not be on them.
- Overcrowding stairs is dangerous and you are blocking the egress for Firefighters who may need to exit without warning ...

If you are **NOT** moving up them or down them, then you should **NOT** be on them.

Overcrowding stairs is **DANGEROUS** and you are blocking the egress for Firefighters that may need it without warning.

# Leadership in the Fire Service

Leadership is all about human interaction. To be an effective leader, you must become a student of human relations. Leadership involves:

- Establishing a clear vision
- Sharing that vision with others so that they will follow willingly
- Providing information and outlining methods that lead to the realization of that vision
- Balancing the conflicting interests of all members and stakeholders
